Functional Area Description

This functional area includes conducting mid-and long-range planning programming and budgeting for security assistance and security cooperation programs. This function includes Title 10 and Title 22 programs and activities that provide materiel assistance and related tactical and operational training to partners to develop specific defense capabilities (e.g., the consolidated train-and-equip programs) including all relevant processes and resourcing mechanisms.

BPC professionals will understand their operating environments, become familiar with SC activities in their regions, and be able to synchronize and sequence many tools, processes, and timelines to make a difference in the world of security cooperation.
